Guidelines on Reviewing Qualifications for Doctoral Dissertation Oral

- I. The Guidelines on Reviewing Qualifications for Doctoral Dissertation Oral Defense by College of Intelligent Science and Technology at I-Shou University (hereinafter referred to as "the Guidelines") are made by the College of Intelligent Science and Technology (hereinafter referred to as "the College") to review the qualifications for doctoral dissertation oral defense.
- II. A review panel for the qualifications for doctoral dissertation oral defense shall be established by the College. The review panel is composed of three to five members appointed by the Dean of the College. The Dean of the College shall serve as the ex-officio member and convener of the review panel.
- III. Doctoral candidates shall not file an application for doctoral dissertation oral defense to the College until their departments verify their qualifications.

- IV. The academic works of applicants for doctoral dissertation oral defense shall include journal papers published or certified to be published and international conference papers presented orally in person.
- V. The Guidelines become effective on the third day of promulgation after being adopted by the College Affairs Council and ratified by the President.

Note: In case of any disputes or misunderstanding regarding the interpretation of the language or terms of these Guidelines, the Chinese language version shall prevail.
